**Additional storey to bungalow to create a two storey dwelling and dropped kerb**

Thank you for re-consulting the Highway Authority on the above planning application. The Highway Authority wishes to make the following comments.

In response to our previous comments, an updated parking layout drawing (Y2450/2025-A02 Rev 02) has been submitted. The proposed access and dropped kerb will now be widened to prevent vehicles having to drive onto the full-height kerb and perform an awkward manoeuvre to access the parking spaces. Additionally, the gully on Park Lane has now been incorporated into this drawing, with the applicant noting that the gully will be retained and require reinforcement. This can be undertaken at the s171/184 stage.

**Recommendations**

These proposals have been considered and in review are not anticipated to result in a significant impact to the safety or operation of the local highway network. Therefore, the Highway Authority have no objection to the proposals subject to the following informative.

**S171/174 Informative:**

The applicant should be aware that as the proposals include the formation of a new or altered access onto the highway, these works will be required to be undertaken in accordance with standards laid down by, and under a Section 171/184 license agreement with the Highway Authority.
